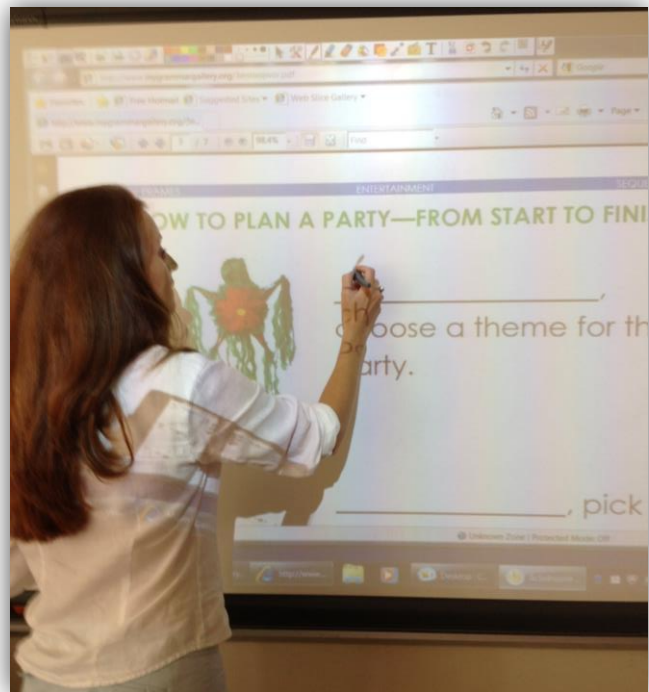
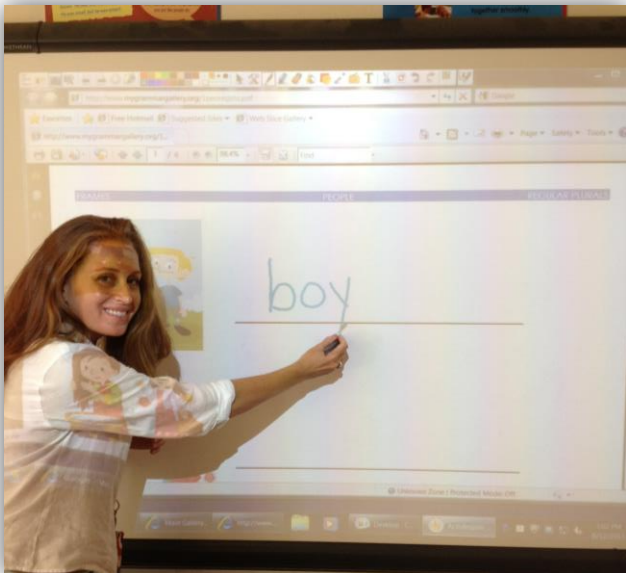




Using Grammar Gallery with a Promethean Board

1. Launch ActiveInspire on your workstation. From the **dashboard**, click on **annotate over the desktop**. If ActiveInspire is open on your workstation, go to the tools tab and click on **annotate over the desktop**. For two students, click on the **dual user** tab under tools.
2. Log into Grammar Gallery and choose your activity.
3. By annotating over the desktop, your students will be able to write, highlight and draw, and be actively involved in the lesson. The teacher will be able to assess students quickly and easily.
4. Remember to adjust the size of the PDF files to fit your particular needs and to calibrate your board for best possible viewing.
